OML Issues Policy Priorities for Economic Recovery

COLUMBUS - The Ohio Municipal League (OML) has issued a memo to Governor DeWine and the House and Senate leadership detailing their policy requests for economic recovery in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The policy recommendations in the memo cover the need for municipal funding to sustain public services, investment in infrastructure and the need for expanded furlough authority as well as concerns regarding federal financial relief and the Local Government Fund (LGF).

The League is looking forward to working alongside the DeWine Administration and the General Assembly to rebuild a strong and vibrant economy in Ohio.
